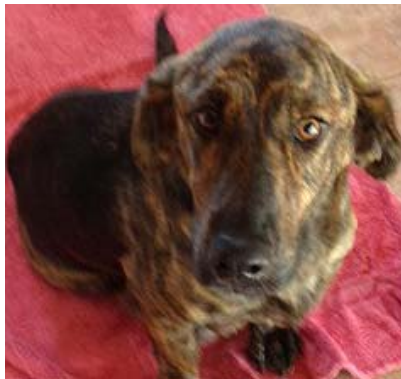

Clover is a sweet, new mom that came to us recently. She gave birth to 9 puppies the day after coming to RFSC.

We had received a call from a woman who works in Perris. She said that there was a dog that had been living in the parking lot of her place of employment. She said the dog had been there for about 6 months.

The poor dog was now showing signs of being pregnant and this kind woman knew that she had to get this dog off the streets, but she had no place to take her.

She contacted RFSC and we agreed to help. We named the dog Clover and she gave birth to 9 puppies the day after coming to RFSC. Clover looks like a Basset Hound and a Dachshund mix.

We have worked hard to care for her and the puppies. We have found homes for 4 of the pups as of today. With the skills of our wonderful veterinarian, Clover and all of her

pups have been spayed and neutered. With the continued help of our volunteers, Clover and her pups are still receiving the very best care.

One of our special volunteers, Claudette, spent many hours caring for Clover and her pups. Claudette is an exceptional volunteer who gives her time to help RFSC by providing care for the many small dogs in our program. Claudette fell in love with Clover and had promised her a home for life. She changed Clovers name to Gypsy and now Gypsy has a new family with 2 other adopted dogs.

This is one of the many stories of so many animals in need. Animals who live on the streets and do not have much of a chance of having veterinary care and a safe home, especially mothers like Gypsy.

Thanks to the kind woman who took the time to find help for a dog she found on the streets and thanks to RFSC, this sweet mom and her 9 pups were saved.

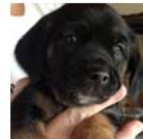
